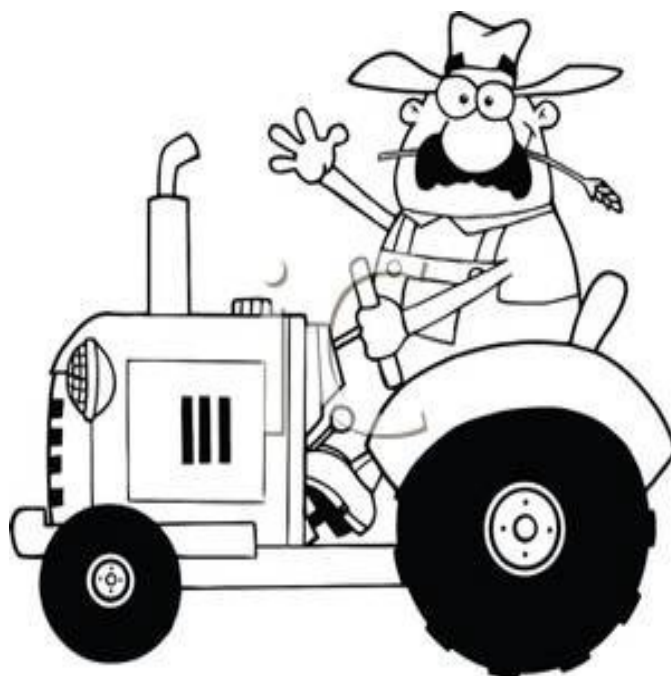

VENUE

The Dairy Goat Section is held beside the Goat Pavilion which is to the right of the main showgrounds gate on State Highway 12. Travelling West out of Paparoa, go past the Paparoa Hotel on the left, the Paparoa War Memorial Hall is next on the right. The Showgrounds gate is two gates past the hall.

GATE ENTRY

Adults: \$10 Children: \$5 per child for the first two children, under 5-year olds free.

SMOKE FREE SHOW

Smoking is NOT ALLOWED anywhere on the Show Grounds.

DOGS

The only dogs allowed are those permitted by legislation e.g. guide dogs or police dogs and competition dogs are permitted on the Showgrounds.

Any others will be removed by the competitor/owner and any competitor with a dog will be disqualified.

COMPETITORS PARKING

After unloading your animals, please park your trucks, floats, trailers in the marked designated area adjacent to the Goat arena.

DAIRY GOAT SECTION

Includes local classes for unregistered goats under the following rules:

- All goats exhibited must be registered with NZGBA or another RAS affiliated organisation except for the following:
- Local goat entries must be owned and exhibited by a resident of the North Kaipara District which includes Mangawhai, Kaiwaka, Maungaturoto, Paparoa, Ruawai and the rural areas surrounding these places.

- Pet Goat Classes can be for both registered and unregistered goats and have no entry fee.

Competition starts at 10.00am

Pet Goat Classes will be held at **lunch time** – rosettes to third place and sponsored prizes (see classes at end of this programme).

CLASSES

Herd Register Standard Age Classes

Class 1: Doe in milk 1 - 2 years

Class 2: Kiddled Doe in milk 3 years and over

Herd Register Champion and Reserve Champion

Class 3: Herd Register Grand Champion Age Class

Open to does that have gained their GCH Prefix or are pending award.

HR Champion Challenge Herd Register Champion Challenge Doe

(winner of Class 3 to be paraded with Champion Doe. No award if there is no competition)

Association Records Standard Age Classes

Class 4: Kiddled Doe in milk aged 2 years and under

Class 5: Kiddled doe in milk aged 3 years and over

Associated Record Champion Doe, Reserve Champion Doe

Class 6: Associated Record Grand Champion Age Class

Open to Does that have gained their GCH Prefix or are pending the award

AR Champion Challenge Associated Records Champion Challenge Doe

Winner of Class 6 to be paraded with Champion Doe. No award if there is no competition.

Champion Doe – Val McMillan Trophy

Champion Doe, to be selected from the HR Champion Challenge Doe and the AR Champion Challenge Doe. If there is no Champion Challenge Doe (either HR or AR) then the Champion Doe from that section is to be paraded for the Champion Doe.

Class 7: Local Doe in milk any age

Special Classes

NOTE: Goats must be entered in Standard Age Classes to be eligible for entry to these sections

Class 8: Senior Progeny -two does in milk, same sire, different dams

Name of sire and dam to be entered on entry form

Class 9: Herd Register Type and Production

To be judged according to NZDGBA Rules. Details of Test Production to be supplied with entries.

Class 10: Associated Record Type and Production (rules as above)

Class 11: Herd Register Best Udder

Class 12: Associated Records Best Udder

Class 13: Local Best Udder

Class 14: Junior Showmanship

Class 15: Junior Herdsperson

Herd Register Standard Age Classes

Class 16: Maiden doe or goatling under 30 months that has not borne a kid

Class 17: Maiden doe kid born on or before 31 August

Class 18: Maiden doe kid born after 31 August

Herd Register Junior Champion and Reserve Champion to be selected from

Classes 16, to 18.

Herd Register Junior Champion, Junior Reserve Champion

Associated Records Standard Age Classes

Class 19: Maiden doe or goatling under 30 months of age which has not borne a kid

Class 20: Maiden doe kid born on or before 31 August

Class 21: Maiden doe kid born after 31 August

Associated Records Champion and Reserve Champion to be selected from winners of Classes 19 to 21.

Associated Records Junior Champion, Junior Reserve Champion

Class 22: Local Junior Goat -open to doe kid or goatling which has not borne a kid

Class 23: Junior Progeny Group -two doe kids or goatlings, same sire, different dams – names to be supplied on entry forms.

BUCKS

Herd Register Standard Age Classes

Class 24: Buck kid under 12 months

Class 25: Buckling, 12 months and under 2 years

Class 26: Buck, 2 years and over

Champion Buck and Reserve Champion Buck to be selected from winners of Classes 25 and 26.

Herd Register Champion, Reserve Champion

Class 27: Grand Champion Age Class – bucks-open to bucks that have gained their GCH Prefix or are pending the award

Champion Challenge Buck

Buck Winner of Class 27 to be paraded with the Champion Buck. No award made if there is no competition in this class.

Supreme Champion

The Champion Challenge Herd Register Doe, Champion Challenge, Associated Records Doe, Herd Register Junior Champion Doe, Associated Records Junior Champion Doe, Buck Kid and Champion Challenge Buck are to be paraded. If there is no Champion Challenge Award the Champion is to be paraded.

Breed Awards

Herd Register Does and Herd Register Bucks that have not been beaten by a goat of the same breed.

PET GOAT CLASSES

Class 1: Rearing and Presentation

Handler to be asked the breed and when it was born, how goat is fed and how it was prepared for showing.

Class 2: Leading and Control

After doing this with their own goat, swap with another and see how well it performs with a different handler.

Class 3: Obstacle Course

Class 4: Most responsive goat to calling by handler.
